A warty lesion on the forehead – A clinical dilemma

- Dr.Anmika, Sri Ramachandra Medical College.

- A 65-year-old male, farmer by profession, presented to the OPD with chief complaints of dome shaped skin lesion over right side of forehead for the past 2 months.
- The lesion started as an asymptomatic smooth papule, which rapidly increased in size to attain the current size. History of increase on sun exposure.
- History of mild pain present.
- Known case of type 2 diabetes mellitus on treatment.

Dermatological examination:

- A single skin coloured nodule of size 1x1 cm present over the right side of forehead with keratin filled depression in the centre.
- Tenderness present on lateral pressure.
- Histopathology shows keratin filled crater at the center , peripheral epidermal lipping present.
- Complete surgical excision was done.
