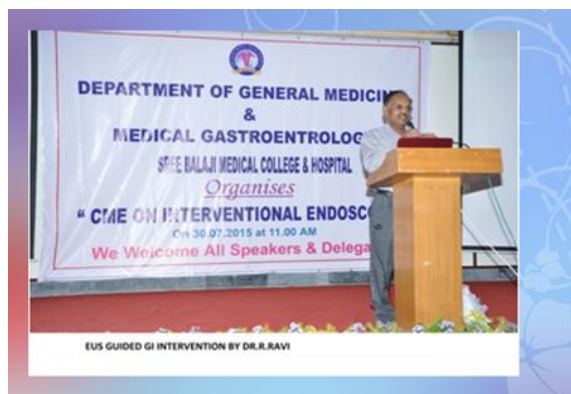

CME PROGRAMME CELLULAR TRANSPORT MECHANISM

Department of Physiology & Medical Education conducted a "CME PROGRAMME CELLULAR TRANSPORT MECHANISM" 23.09.2015. Speaker: Dr D.C. MATHANGI. There are four types of transport mechanisms in a cell. These are simple diffusion, facilitated diffusion, primary active transport and secondary active transport. Cellular mechanism have



been studied in vitro, in cell cultures and animal studies, which indicate that solvents induce changes in the lipid structure of cell membranes which interfere with synaptic membrane transport mechanisms and disturb intercellular communication.
