Spirometry Workshop

Department of Respiratory Medicine conducted spirometry workshop on 18.10.2022. Spirometry is the most common of the pulmonary function tests, measuring lung function

specifically the amount or flow of air that can be inhaled and exhaled. Spirometry is an important tool used for assessing conditions such as asthma, COPD and pulmonary fibrosis. Unlike other tests, spirometry is the test which is entirely dependent on patient effort. Therefore, a good quality spirometry report depends on good test procedure which in turn is dependent on a well-trained spirometry technician, who should be well versed with the ATS/ERS guidelines. In reality most, spirometryare done by untrained, non-technical personnel without proper theoretical or practical knowledge and no hands-on training. This results in suboptimal efforts which could lead to wrong diagnosis.

Doctors know that breast cancer occurs when some breast cells begin to grow abnormally.

These cells divide more rapidly than healthy cells do and continue to accumulate, forming a lump or mass. Cells may spread (metastasize) through your breast to your lymph nodes or to other parts of your body. Mammography is the most common screening test for breast cancer. Cancer begins when healthy cells in the breast change and grow out of control, forming a





mass or sheet of cells called a tumor. Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) may be used to screen women who have a high risk of breast cancer. Whether a woman should be screened for breast cancer and the screening test to use depends on certain factors.

Voluntary Blood Donation Awareness Camp, In RHTC, Padappai on 1/10/2022





To create awareness to the general public on Voluntary Blood donation Blood transfusion is an indispensable component of health care. Still many patients die or suffer unnecessarily because they do not have access to safe blood transfusion. In many developing and transitional countries there is a widespread shortfall between blood requirements and blood supplies. A voluntary blood donor gives blood, plasma or cellular components of his or her own free will and receives no payment. The countries with the highest levels of blood donation are Austria (66%), France (52%), Greece and the Republic of Cyprus (51%).

General Hygiene Awareness Camp, In Vanchuvancheri on 17/10/2022

The objective is to create health awareness for general hygiene. The school students from 1st to 5th std belonging to Govt, Primary school, Vanchuvancheri, were visited for a health awareness camp. 2009 to 2016 – Stability

From the academic year 2013 -2014, the student intake was raised to 150 students, and in the consecutive year the student strength increased to 250 per year. The challenges to be faced were anticipated to be multifold with the admission of 250 students, but thanks to the smart planning and adept execution of tasks by the faculty, we were able to handle the 250 students very efficiently. In 2009, Post graduate admissions was approved followed by this the first batch of PG students in Anatomy joined the department.




Part: 3

This period saw the joining of newer members to the family, retirement of the senior members and Dr W.M.S. Johnson becoming the Head of the department of Anatomy.

There was a huge surge in academic excellence. Four of the faculty members completed their PhD. Three new faculty members joined PhD.


This was also the era of the COVID pandemic, the faculty had to brainstorm a way out, soon the department quickly transformed into an online cloud, classes were online, cadaveric dissections were recorded, histology slides and x rays were photographed and taught to the students. This led to a major transformation in the history of Anatomy teaching. Thanks to COVID-19 lockdowns, we had a self-directed faculty development program on incorporation of technology in teaching Anatomy.

The quest for research and publication also was high with 5 to 6 ongoing projects per year, patents getting granted and numerous research publications in national and international journals indexed in scopus, pubmed and web of science.



Academic Activities

This period also has remarkable growth spurt in academic field. Many CMEs, Conferences, workshops and student-centred academic programs were conducted.



The important conferences included the FICAA International conference which was done in collaboration with the Russian federation and the Europian hepatobiliary association. The Conference on recent trends on research and review, famously called the RRR conference had speakers from West Indies to talk on how to write a research article.











Student Activity Programs

The department of Anatomy conducts student activity programs every year to explore the talents of the students. The major student activity programs included Infocov-19, conducted online during the COVID pandemic. In 2021 we conducted the Young Anatomist fest, Elixer and Anatomy quiz in 2022. The student activity programs included student seminar, debate, anatomical drawing, role plays, elocution, essay writing, quiz etc. These

gave a break to the students' monotonous and hectic routine and helped them to drive back rejuvenated to the curriculum.



Faculty extracurricular activities: The department encourages faculty to participate in sports and cultural events in the college.

Infrastructure development: The infrastructure of the department developed phenomenally, with advent of smart board in demonstration rooms and histology labs, and procurement of advanced microscopes and cadaver storage and cutting equipment.

The faculty have published books and edited chapters. The most recent one being, Ross and Willson Applied Anatomy and Applied Physiology in health and illness' 1st south Asian edition.

With over 554 registered patients under the care of expert team (Plastic Surgeon, Oro-Maxillofacial surgeon, Prosthodontist, Orthodontists, Speech, and Language Pathologists, Paediatric and Neonatal Nutritionist, Specialized Feeding Nurse, and Project Coordinators) receiving quality care. The team consists of highly qualified Director (1) Professors (5), Associate Professors and Assistant Professors (3).

Modalities/Diseases Treated

Surgical: Cleft Lip & Palate, Craniofacial Anomalies, General Plastic Dental: Orthodontic Treatment (supported by Sree Balaji Dental College) for Individuals with Cleft lip & Palate, Paediatric Dentistry. Speech & Language Therapy: For Children and Adult Children with delayed speech and language, autism, hearing loss, stuttering, learning disability, voice problems, pronunciation errors, cerebral palsy, Feeding & Swallowing problems. Adults with Speech, Language & Swallowing Problems Post Stroke, Head & Neck Cancer, Voice Problems and Stuttering. Nutrition: Assessment of Babies born with cleft lip & palate. Nutrition Counselling for mother's during Pregnancy and Lactation. Educating the mothers on the importance of breastfeeding, importance of Hygiene and Sanitation and basic infant care. To emphasize the parents on Feeding position, duration, and the measures to be taken care of. To counsel the mothers to initiate age appropriate complementary feeding for babies after 6 months of age. Feeding: Giving feeding advice to parents. How to give milk and how put the position of head. Place the baby in an upright position to prevent the formula from flowing back to the nose area. Before feed the baby first needs to be burped more often because they take more air while the baby sleeping and feeding. Advice with the paladai and bottle and spoon like many of types to feed. follow up the parents every 15 days once about the feeding and gaining weight.


Research Grants

Sree Balaji Dental College and Hospital Cleft and Craniofacial department headed by Dr. Badri Thiruvenkatachari has been awarded a research grant of 4.68 Crores to improve the quality of life and reduce the treatment burden for patients with cleft lip and palate. This is the largest grant to be awarded to any dental institution in the country. The grant comes from Department of Biotechnology, India and Wellcome Trust, UK (India Alliance) to look into the effectiveness of a nasoalveolar moulding (NAM) treatment for babies born with cleft lip and palate.









