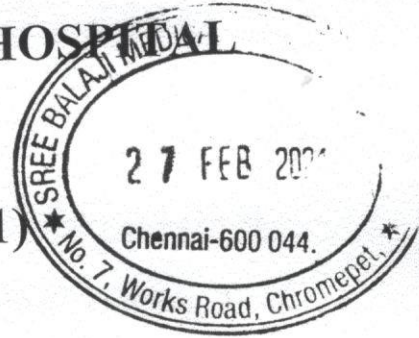

CURRICULUM COMMITTEE-MINUTES OF MEETING

The curriculum committee meeting was held on **08.12.21** in the MEU room 2nd floor College block and was attended by the curriculum committee members and Phase III coordinators for the time table

Agenda 1. To discuss on the phase – III time table

Resolution 1: The Curriculum committee head Dr.P.Subhashini greeted all the members present and addressed the agenda. The convenor of phase – III time Dr.Chandrasekar (HOD of Ophthalmology) presented the time table, all members scrutinized the time table for the presence of 70 percent alignment and intergration and also checked the non aligned topics. Suggestions were given for alignment and appropriate colours to be added respectively. It was decided that the final corrected copy will be checked by the head of curriculum committee followed by which it will be presented in MEU meeting for approval.

Agenda 2: To discuss on assessment pattern and suggestions given by the COE (Controller of Examination) at the Board of Studies conducted on 03.12.21

Agenda 3: To discuss on the implementation of “Learner - doctor method of clinical training”

Resolution 3: Dr.J.Thanka Vice Principal and Member secretary of MEU addressed the agenda, she asked the forum, the plan of action for this new clinical training programme rolled out by NMC and how it can be implemented. After discussion with all other members present in the meeting it was decided that documentation of the clinical training programme is mandatory by the students and it will be conducted during clinical posting hours and each student will record and follow up minimum of 4 patients during their period of clinical posting. Agenda 4. : To discuss on implementation of remedial classes for low achievers in all phases of UG curriculum:
