**AGENDA OF THE MEETING**

- Introduction of the members was done by Dr.Rainya Ravichandar, Medical scientist.
- The following proposals were presented:
  - 1) "Development and validation of a serious videogame and the evaluation of its efficacy for behavior modification among depressed patients" - Principal investigator:Dr.V.M. Anantha Eashwar.
  - 2) "Cross Sectional Study to Compare the Diagnostic Potency of BMD Digitometer With DXA Scan and Singh Index for Diagnosing Osteoporosis in Post Menopausal Women"- Principal investigator: Dr.K.Prabhu.
- The following minor modifications were suggested by the members:

Proposal-1: "Development and validation of a serious videogame and the evaluation of its efficacy for behavior modification among depressed patients"

- 1) Details of the game developers to be included in the proposal.
- 2) Duration of game play to be restricted.
- 3) Permission from certification authority to be obtained.
- 4) Psychiatrist to be included as co-principal investigator.
- 5) Randomization process to be clearly explained in the patient information sheet and informed consent form.

Proposal-2:"Cross Sectional Study to Compare the Diagnostic Potency of BMD Digitometer With DXA Scan and Singh Index for Diagnosing Osteoporosis in Post Menopausal Women"

- 1) Age group of the study population to be specified as post-menopausal women.
- 2) Patient information sheet and informed consent form to be submitted.
- 3) Randomization methods to be clearly explained.

- APPROVAL- The proposals will be approved after submitting the revised protocols with the minor modifications suggested by the IEC-CT Committee.
