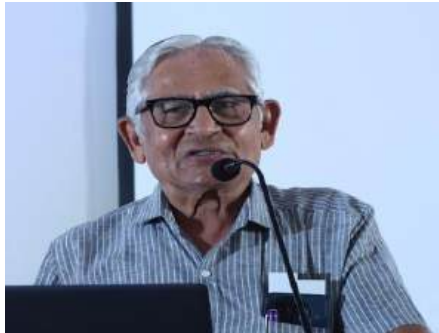


WORLD HAND HYGIENE DAY

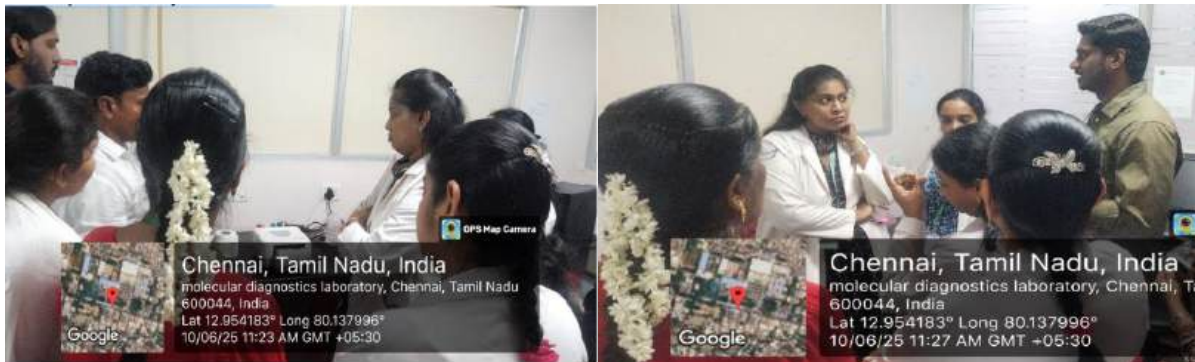

40th DERMATOLOGY INTERCOLLEGIATE MEET

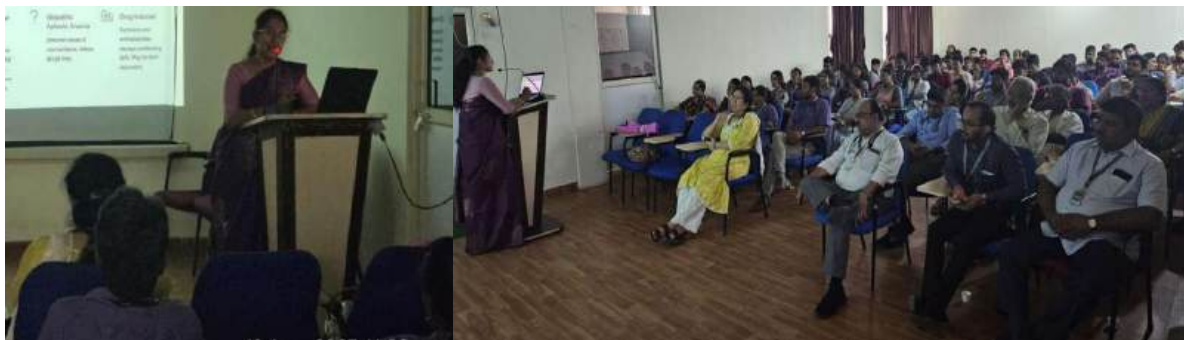

Sree Balaji Medical College Hospital saves patient with head, neck surgery



Chennai, Mar 19: The Department of ENT at Sree Balaji Medical College and Hospital, Chennai, under the expert guidance of Prof. Dr. M. K. Rajasekar has performed another breakthrough in the field of Head and Neck surgery by operating on a 65-year-old male patient from Kottam and saved his life.

He was severely affected by the tumor and diagnosed as Paranasal carcinoma of the Left Common Carotid artery with the help of various imaging scans. Dr. M. K. Rajasekar advised that the patient come to us with intention of such swelling following a mild infection which was initially seen in size and increased rapidly to attain the present size. He also had compression over trachea and oesophagus. The patient underwent MRI neck followed by CT Angiography in which the pseudoaneurysm of the left common carotid artery overpressing the trachea and oesophagus was diagnosed. After getting opinions from the cardiologist, neurologist and vascular surgeon, the patient was taken up for resection of the pseudoaneurysm with patch plasty and embolization under general anaesthesia.

The pseudoaneurysm sac which was causing the pressure symptoms due to compression over trachea and oesophagus was resected by the ENT surgeons. The rest was repaired by the vascular surgeon. Complete excision of the sac and repair of the same prevents formation of the pseudoaneurysm in the future. Post-operatively patient is doing good without any issues.

The significance of this case is that only 1% of the population will have a pseudoaneurysm of the common carotid artery with 80% of narrowing of the left common carotid artery. Managing a carotid artery pseudoaneurysm with compression is a procedure for which the future and need the expertise at such medical college hospital to head and neck surgery.
