HANDS ON WORKSHOP – TRAUMA

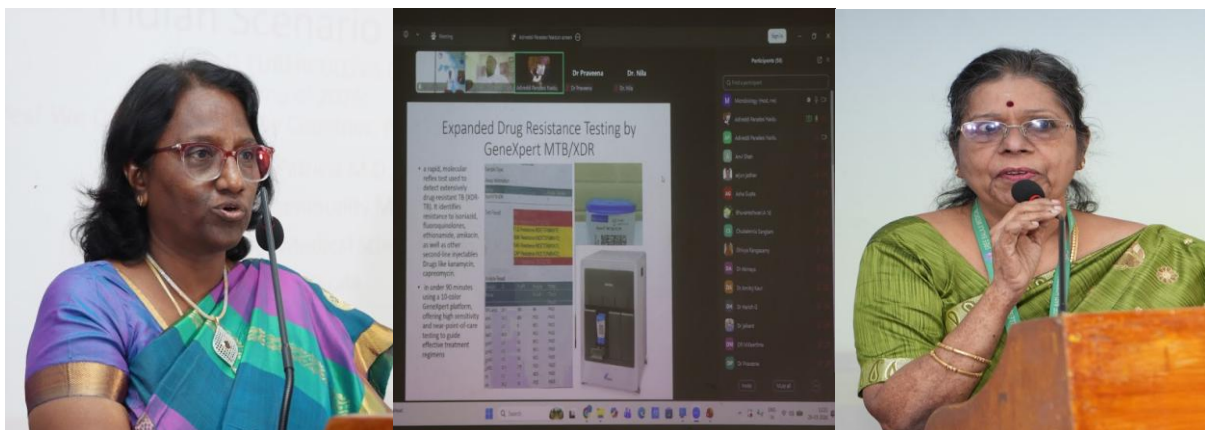

Topic - Digital Therapeutics and Telemedicine in GDM delivered by Dr. Sindhuja M, Digital therapeutics (DTx) and telemedicine are increasingly transforming the management of gestational diabetes mellitus (GDM) by enabling continuous, personalized, and remote care. DTx platforms use evidence-based software interventions—often delivered via mobile applications—to support glucose monitoring, dietary guidance, physical activity tracking, and behavioral modification. GDM: A metabolic crossword of mother and future delivered by Dr Reshmi S. Gestational diabetes mellitus (GDM) represents a critical metabolic intersection affecting both maternal and future offspring health. It arises due to pregnancy-induced insulin resistance combined with inadequate pancreatic β -cell compensation, leading to hyperglycemia. For the mother, GDM increases the risk of hypertensive disorders, cesarean delivery, and progression to type 2 diabetes later in life.



Topic : Gdm Screening In India And Diagnosis Bridging Policy And Practice delivered by Dr. Haritha Sagili, Gestational diabetes mellitus (GDM) screening in India is guided by national recommendations such as those from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Diabetes in Pregnancy Study Group India, which advocate universal screening due to high disease burden. This approach is practical for low-resource settings and improves coverage. Topic : Contemporary Management of GDM: Guidelines, Gaps & Ground Reality by Dr. Priyadarshini M, Gestational diabetes mellitus (GDM) screening in India is guided by national recommendations such as those from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Diabetes in Pregnancy Study Group India, which advocate universal screening due to high disease burden. diabetes mellitus (GDM) integrates evidence-based guidelines with individualized care. Recommendations from bodies such as the American Diabetes Association and Federation of Obstetric and Gynaecological Societies of India emphasize medical, nutrition therapy (MNT), regular physical activity, and self-monitoring of blood glucose as first-line, interventions. Pharmacotherapy, primarily insulin, is initiated when glycemic targets are unmet; selected, oral agents may be considered in specific settings. Session 4: Panel Discussion; Managing hyperglycemia in pregnancy: Where do we stand



Management of hyperglycemia in pregnancy, including gestational diabetes and pre-existing diabetes, has evolved toward tighter glycemic control and individualized care. Current recommendations from the American Diabetes Association and World Health Organization emphasize early screening, risk stratification, and prompt initiation of therapy. First-line management includes medical nutrition therapy, structured physical activity, and self-monitoring of blood glucose. When targets are not achieved, insulin remains the gold standard due to its safety and efficacy, while selected oral agents like metformin are used in



specific cases. Despite advances, challenges persist, including late diagnosis, limited access to care, poor compliance, and variability in clinical practice. In low-resource settings, implementation gaps and lack of uniform protocols hinder optimal outcomes. Emerging approaches such as continuous glucose monitoring and telemedicine are improving

surveillance and adherence. Overall, while guidelines are well established, bridging the gap between evidence and real-world practice remains crucial to improve maternal and fetal outcomes. Guest speaker; Dr. Sowmiya Baskaran, Medical Advisor at Abbott. Clinical Research is the systematic study involving human subjects to improve the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of diseases. It forms the basis of Evidence-Based Medicine, helping doctors make decisions using scientific evidence. A well-framed research question is essential for successful research because it guides the study design, data collection, and analysis. A good research question should be clear, focused, feasible, ethical, and relevant. The FINER criteria (Feasible, Interesting, Novel, Ethical, and Relevant) help evaluate research questions. The commonly used PICO framework helps structure questions using Population, Intervention, Comparison, and Outcome. Thus, framing a clear and structured research question is the first and most important step in clinical research.
