The Department of Microbiology and Hospital Infection Control of Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital Conducted workshop on 24.06.2026 in the Department of Microbiology, Practical laboratory, the workshop topic was “Parasitology” In this Workshop, Dr. Praveena. R, inaugurated the program, followed by demonstration life cycle, Pathogenesis and lab diagnosis of different parasites. This workshop was moderated by Dr. Bindu. D. Gallbladder carcinoma is a rare and aggressive cancer that starts in the small organ under your liver. Key facts include its strong link to gallstones, frequent lack of early symptoms, and primary treatment via surgery



GUEST LECTURE ON OTODERMATOLOGY

Department of DVL organized a Guest Lecture on Otodermatology on 27.06.2026. Lectured delivered by Dr. K. Paventhan, Prof & HOD of ENT, Adhiparasakthi Medical College. Dr Paventhan discussed the clinical presentation, etiopathogenesis, and distinguishing features of a wide spectrum of dermatological conditions affecting the ear. The lecture covered common and clinically significant ear skin disorders, including inflammatory, infective, autoimmune, benign, and premalignant lesions. Emphasis was placed on careful clinical examination, differential diagnosis, appropriate investigative modalities when indicated, and evidence-based management strategies. Dr. Paventhan also highlighted the importance of recognizing early warning signs of malignant and systemic diseases presenting with auricular skin manifestations and stressed the role of timely referral and multidisciplinary care when necessary. Special attention was given to correlating dermatological findings with otological symptoms, enabling clinicians to adopt a systematic approach to the evaluation of patients presenting with ear skin lesions. Practical clinical pearls and management algorithms were shared to help avoid misdiagnosis and unnecessary interventions. Case-based discussions enriched the session by illustrating the varied presentations of otodermatological disorders, enhancing clinical reasoning and enabling postgraduate students to correlate clinical findings with underlying pathology and appropriate treatment options.



The lecture concluded with an engaging interactive discussion, during which postgraduate students actively clarified their doubts and explored practical approaches to the diagnosis and management of skin lesions affecting the ear. The session was highly informative and

significantly contributed to strengthening clinical knowledge and diagnostic skills in the field of otodermatology.

WORKSHOP ON A STITCH IN TIME” : FUNDAMENTALS OF EARLOBE REPAIR

Department of DVL organized a Workshop on A Stitch In Time” : Fundamentals Of Earlobe Repair on 27.06.2026. Delivered by Dr. K. Paventhan, Prof & HOD of ENT, Adhiparasakthi Medical College. Dr. K. Paventhan began the session by introducing the concept of otodermatology, emphasizing the importance of the ear as a unique anatomical structure in dermatological and aesthetic practice. The basic earlobe anatomy and vascular supply was explained. The common causes of split and torn earlobes, and indications for earlobe repair were discussed in detail. Various techniques of earlobe repair, including simple layered closure, freshening of wound edges, flap techniques for complex defects, and methods to prevent recurrence, were explained with the aid of clinical photographs and surgical videos. The highlight of the workshop was the live demonstration of earlobe repair performed on patients with partial and complete split earlobes. Dr. Paventhan demonstrated patient selection, preoperative marking, local anesthesia, surgical technique, tissue handling, layered suturing, postoperative care, and appropriate timing for ear re-piercing. Practical tips to achieve optimal cosmetic outcomes while minimizing complications such as notching, scar widening, and recurrence were also shared. The postgraduate students were given hands-on exposure under expert guidance, allowing them to gain confidence in basic surgical techniques and suture handling. This was followed by an interactive question-and-answer session, during which participants discussed challenging clinical scenarios, surgical modifications, complication management, and postoperative follow-up protocols.
